Patient Minor Surgery Satisfaction Outcome Questionnaire 2014/15


As part of our minor surgery review we decided last year that our current satisfaction questionnaire addresses issues of satisfaction around the appointment but does not measure the success of the procedure. As a result we have developed an additional questionnaire, posted to patients post operatively, examining the outcome of the procedure, as measured against the patients' expectations, in an attempt to shape our service further.


Method


2-3 months post op questionnaires are posted out to all patients who have undergone a minor surgery procedure (see appendix I). A stamped addressed envelope is included.


Results


Over a six month period we have had approximately 50% response rate to our questionnaires. Our results can be seen below. A copy of the raw data and patient comments is given in Appendix II.











Discussion

Our results demonstrate the service provided is attaining excellent outcomes for our patients, with 82% agreeing or strongly agreeing they are very satisfied with the results of the procedure. This is also borne out with aftercare as 94% agreed or strongly agreed they had no problem with their wound after surgery. 88% would recommend this service to other patients. We will continue to monitor these outcomes.
